STRUCTURE, POWER AND FUNCTION OF WORLD BANK

INTRODUCTION

- The World Bank Group works in every major area of development, providing a wide array of financial products and technical assistance, and help countries share and apply innovative knowledge and solutions to the challenges they face.
- With 189 member countries, staff from more than 170 countries, and offices in over 130 locations, the World Bank Group is a unique global partnership: five institutions working for sustainable solutions that reduce poverty and build shared prosperity in developing countries.

HISTORY

- The Bretton Woods Conference, officially known as the United Nations Monetary and Financial Conference, was a gathering of delegates from 44 nations that met from July 1 to 22, 1944, in Bretton Woods, New Hampshire (USA), to agree upon a series of new rules for international financial and monetary order after the conclusion of World War II.
- The two major accomplishments of the conference were the creation of the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD) and International Monetary Fund (IMF).
- Founded in 1944, the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD) — later called the World Bank — has expanded to a clearly associated group of five development institutions.
- The Bank Group works with country governments, the private sector, civil society organizations, regional development banks, think tanks, and other international institutions.

CONT...

- In the 1950s and 60s, the funding of large infrastructure projects, such as dams, electrical grids, irrigation systems, and roads was the Bank's primary focus.
- In the 1970s, the Bank shifted its attention to poverty eradication.
- Bank operations also expanded to identify and encourage policies, strategies, and institutions that helped countries succeed.
- In the 1980s, the Bank continued to enlarge its focus on issues of social development.
- World Bank Group headquarters, Washington, DC
- For over seventy years, the World Bank Group has been a leader in the field of international development and poverty reduction, but it has also worked alongside or in support of other governments, institutions, and organizations that share its goals.

STRUCTURE:-

- The World Bank is like a cooperative, made up of 189 member countries.
- These member countries, or shareholders, are represented by a board of governor, who are the ultimate policymakers at the World Bank.
- Generally, the governors are member countries' ministers of finance or ministers of development.
- They meet once a year at the annual meetings of the Boards of Governors of the World Bank.
- The governors delegate specific duties to 25 executive director.
- The five largest shareholders appoint an executive director, while other member countries are represented by elected executive directors.

CONT...

- The President is selected by the Board of Executive Directors for a five-year, renewable term. President chairs meetings of the Boards of Directors and is responsible for overall management of the Bank.
- The Executive Directors make up the boards of directors of the World Bank.
- They normally meet at least twice a week to oversee the Bank's business, including approval of loans and guarantees, new policies, the administrative budget, country assistance strategies and borrowing and financial decisions.
- The World Bank operates day-to-day under the leadership and direction of the president, management and senior staff, and the vice presidents in charge of Global Practices, Cross-Cutting Solutions Areas, regions, and functions.

WORLD BANK AND INDIA

- India was one of the forty-four original signatories to the agreements reached at Bretton Woods that established the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD) and the International Monetary Fund (IMF).
- It was also one of the founding members of the IFC in 1956 and the IDA in 1960. India later became a member of the IDA in January 1959.
- India is not a member of ICSD.
- IBRD lending to India commenced in 1946 with a loan for the Indian railways; the first investment by the IFC in India took place in 1950, and the IDA in 1961 (a highway construction project).
- During the 1950s, the IBRD was India's sole source of World Bank borrowings.

CONT...

- India is currently classified as a "blend" country — defined as one in transition from lower middle-income to middle-income — and is creditworthy for lending from both IDA and IBRD.
- India is the largest IBRD client of the World Bank. Between 2015 and 2018, the World Bank lent around \$10.2 billion to India.
- The World Bank Group (WBG) has approved a \$25-30 billion commitment plan for India for the period 2019-22.
